due course and also will be indicated in the Test Admission Ticket.

#### 1.5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Following are the minimum requirements for admission to Medical / Dental PG Degree and Diploma courses:

- 1) The candidate should have studied and passed the courses leading to the award of MBBS/BDS Degrees in colleges recognized by *Medical Council/Dental Council* of India.
- 2) The candidate should have completed or is completing compulsory rotating internship on or before 30<sup>th</sup> April 2014.
- 3) As per the regulations of statutory bodies, as laid out in Post Graduate Regulation 2000 of Medical Council of India, the minimum percentage of marks in the entrance test for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate courses shall be 50 percent for all candidates and 40% for SC/ST & OBC category as per Govt. of Karnataka regulations.

#### MCI/DCI Norms: Medical and Dental PG Degree and Diploma courses:

Every student, selected for admission to the Post – Graduate Medical/Dental courses in any of the medical institutions in the country, shall possess recognized MBBS/BDS degree or equivalent qualification and should have obtained permanent Registration from the Medical Council of India / Dental Council of India, or any of the State Medical / Dental Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of the admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

Provided that in the case of a foreign nationals, the MCI/DCI may, on payment of the prescribed fee for the registration, grant temporary registration for the duration of the Post – Graduate training restricted to the medical college / institute to which the applicant is admitted for the time being exclusively for postgraduate studies; provided further, that temporary registration to such foreign nationals shall be subjected to the condition that such a person is duly registered as medical practitioner in his own country from which the applicant has obtained his/her basic medical qualification and that his/her degree is recognized by the corresponding medical council or concerned authority.

As per the Post Graduate Regulations 2000 of Medical Council of India, the minimum percentage of marks in the Entrance Test (SSAHE-AIPGET-2014) for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate courses shall be 50% for candidates belong to General Category and 40% for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Govt. of Karnataka regulations ( The certificate is subjected to verification. In case of discrepancy or misrepresentation in the category status will lead to automatic cancellation of admission)

The University reserves the right to approve the admission of the candidate after verifying all the original documents of the applicant. Mere possession of Rank does not qualify an applicant for claiming a seat.

#### 1.6. APPLICATION AND OTHER INFORMATION

The brochure along with the application form (on-line and offline) is available in the University website. The candidate desirous of appearing in the SSAHE - AIPGET - 2014 is required to complete the prescribed *on-line* application form & submit the same to the University *on-line*, on or before the scheduled date 26<sup>th</sup> December 2013. Further the candidate shall take the printout of the application form and submit along with all enclosures mentioned in the brochure so as to reach the university on or before 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2014.

After scrutinizing the application forms the test admission tickets will be generated and dispatched to candidates taking test as per schedule.

The test is scheduled on 18th January 2014 (Saturday) b/w 10.00 am to 1.00 pm at the centers indicated. The mode of conducting test is explained in the later paragraph. After the evaluation, the merit list of eligible candidates will be announced on the university web site.

The counseling date for selection of seats and admission will be notified on the web soon after. The candidates are informed to observe the university website regularly.

#### 2 - ENTRANCE TEST

#### 2.1. ENTRANCE TEST SCHEME

The SSAHE - AIPGET - 2014 will consist of one question paper of 200 multiple choice questions (MCQs) of "single most appropriate answer" type. There will be separate question papers for Medical & Dental courses. The questions will be based on the MCI/DCI prescribed syllabus for MBBS / BDS Courses.

#### 2.2. DURATION, QUESTION PAPER AND ANSWER SHEETS:

- The Entrance Test will be conducted in English.
- The duration of test will be 180 minutes.
- There will be one Question Paper (booklet) consisting of 200 Multiple Choice Questions.
   Questions will be multiple choice types, each having one correct response out of four options.
- Answer sheet is of "Optical Mark Reader" (OMR) type and is required to be marked using only Black Ball Point Pen.
- Each question carries one mark. Correct answer will be awarded -one mark.
- There will be no Negative Marking.

Candidates are instructed to read the instructions printed on OMR sheet before start answering.

#### 2.3. SYLLABUS:

The scope of the syllabi for the postgraduate Medical / Dental entrance test is based on the M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. syllabus as prescribed by MCI/DCI, respectively. The distribution of marks, subject wise, for the entrance test is mentioned below;

#### **2.4.** AT THE ENTRANCE TEST CENTRE:

- Candidate will have to report to the test center at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the test.
- Special procedures like Biometric analysis and Photo-Identification to authenticate the identity of students will be undertaken.
- Except the candidate, no other person will be allowed inside the Test centre.
- Candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall 10 minutes before the commencement of the test on production of the Test admission ticket (1st BELL)
- Candidates have to occupy the seat against their test admission ticket number in the examination hall.
- Candidates have to posses only admission ticket, a ball point pen. No other materials related or not related to the test are allowed in side the examination hall.
- Important instruction will be announced to the candidates before the commencement of the test by the invigilator in side the examination hall.
- The question paper book let (pinned) and OMR Answer sheets will be given to the candidates 5
  minutes before the commencement of test. (2<sup>nd</sup> BELL)
- Candidates have to enter the required information like Name. Admission Ticket Number, Subject, Version Code of question paper, and shade the circles wherever required on the OMR Sheet. Also put Left hand Thumb impression at place indicated on OMR sheet.
- Candidates can open the question paper booklet and start answering only after commencement bell.( 3<sup>rd</sup> BELL)
- Candidates have to enter the OMR answer sheet serial number, affix their signature and put thumb impression in the invigilator diary.
- Candidates will not be allowed to go out of examination hall during test.
- Candidates are expected to keep silence and behave. In case of misbehavior or malpractice the
  authorities have every right to send the candidate out of the hall and there by the candidate
  losses his chance to write the test.
- Five minutes before the closure of the test a warning bell will be made. At this point candidates
  are supposed to check all the entries made, including their signature and left hand thumb
  impression. (4th BELL)
- After the final bell the invigilator will collect the OMR sheets of all the candidates as they are seated.( 5<sup>th</sup> BELL)
- The candidates will leave the exam hall only after the invigilator gives permission.
- Candidates will be not allowed to the test, 30 minutes after commencement of the test.
- Mobiles are prohibited.

#### 2.5. PUBLICATION OF MERIT LIST

The minimum for eligibility criteria in the AIPGET is 50% marks for General Merit candidates and 40% for candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC categories as per Govt. of Karnataka Regulations.

Merit lists in both Medical and Dental faculties are prepared separately on the basis of marks obtained in Entrance Test. In case two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the test, the Marks obtained in III Phase MBBS / IV Yr BDS will be considered for deciding ranking, further ties in the test scores, if any, will be resolved based on the following, in order

- Total aggregate percentage scored in the M.B.B.S / B.D.S exams.
- Number of additional attempts during the course of study, i.e. M.B.B.S / B.D.S.
- The age of the candidate, (the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate).
- In case of tie in all of the above situations, selection will be through draw of lots.

The University will publish the merit / Rank list on its website on the prescribed date. The candidate will be called for counseling as per the Merit / Rank list.

#### 3 - COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

#### 3.1. COUNSELING

The counseling sessions will be conducted at Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education (SSAHE), Agalakote, B.H.Road, Tumkur – 572 107. The dates for counseling of Medical & Dental PG Courses will be announced in due course on the university website. FAILURE TO REPORT FOR COUNSELING ON THE SHEDULED DATE AND TIME WILL RESULT IN INSTANTANEOUS CANCELLATION OF A CLAIM OF THE CANDIDATE TO THE SEAT.

The candidate should remain present for the counseling & for on-the-spot admission, as per the schedule displayed on website, even if he/she fails to receive a letter from the University.

Only the candidate & one of his parents/guardian will be allowed into the hall where counseling is held. The candidates will be called in the order of their Ranking in the merit list & offered the seats to the various courses available at that point of time.

The candidate must note that appearance for the examination & inclusion of name in the eligibility list does not necessarily mean that he/she will get admission to any course. His/her admission to a particular course will depend upon the availability of seats for that particular course at the time of his/her counseling.

After selection the seat, the selected candidate is required to pay the entire amount of annual fee on the day of counseling itself. In case the candidate fails to remit the entire amount of fees, he/she is likely to lose his/her claim for admission to that seat.

#### 3.2. PROCESS OF SEAT SELECTION

The following all stages of selection of seat and admission to course by the candidate.

- a) Registration
- b) Verification of original document
- c) Selection of seat by the candidate
- d) Remittance of fee in the form of Demand Draft
- e) Issue of Allotment letter

Seat once selected it is final and cannot be changed.

If a candidate remains absent for the counseling round, however high score the candidate has got in the entrance test will deemed to have lost his chance of selecting a seat.

#### 3.3. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELING

At the time of counseling, candidate is required to produce the following documents in *original*. Failure to do so will result in instantaneous cancellation the claim for seat selection and admission.

- 1. Letter of Counseling. If the candidate does not receive the Counseling letter he/she should bring Rank Card / Admission Ticket.
- 2. Proof of date of Birth: SSLC/SSC/10<sup>th</sup> Std. Certificate or School / College Leaving Certificate or Certificate of Domicile / Nationality Certificate/ Birth Certificate.
- 3. Marks cards MBBS/ BDS from 1st to final year.
- 4. Attempt Certificate.
- 5. Internship Completion certificate (if not completed, provisional completion letter from Dean/Principal).
- 6. Provisional / Permanent registration of the Medical / Dental Council.
- 7. Degree certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate.
- 8. Conduct and Character Certificate from a Dean/Principal, College last Attended/ Class I officer of the place of residence.
- 9. Migration Certificate.

## 10. Four recent passport-sizes colored photographs. (Same as in test admission ticket)

- 11. MCI / DCI recognition of the college where student has completed the course.
- 12. Tuition fees & other fees in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Secretary, SSMC", Tumkur for Medical courses / "Secretary, SSDC, for Dental Courses, payable at Tumkur.
- **13.** Separate DD for Rs.3000/- Favoring "Registrar, SSAHE", Tumkur, payable at Tumkur towards Eligibility fees.
- **14.** Caste certificate issued by the competent authority for the candidates claiming lower eligibility criteria under SC/ST/OBC category as per Govt. of Karnataka regulations.

#### 3.4. ADMISSION

Immediately after the selection of seat the candidate has to deposit the prescribed fee in the form of Demand Draft (DD) in favour of "Secretary, SSMC, Tumkur" (for Medical Courses), "Secretary, SSDC, Tumkur" (for Dental Courses) and Eligibility fees of Rs.3,000/- in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "The Registrar, SSAHE" payable at Tumkur, Karnataka State. The Candidate then can fill the admission form and submit to respective college office for admission.

#### 3.5. LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the test or seat selection and admission is subject to the jurisdiction of court with in the Tumkur town.
