Applications are invited in the prescribed form so as to reach the undersigned on or before **25.01.2014** from candidates for taking the eligibility examination for the award of Post-Doctoral (General) Fellowship (PDF) of the value of Rs.28000/- p.m. with a contingency grant of Rs. 20000/- p.a. **The examination will be held on 16th February 2014 at New Delhi, Bengaluru and Guwahati.**

- A. The term of the Fellowship shall be for a maximum period of 2 years, extendable by 1 more year in special circumstances if recommended by the Research Projects Committee.
- B. The maximum number of Post-Doctoral (General) Fellowships (PDF) available for the year 2014-2015 is 10 (ten).

C. ELIGIBILITY:

Only candidates who have obtained their Ph D degrees in History/Archaeology/Museology are eligible for this fellowship.

D. An application fee of Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred only) shall be paid in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Deputy Director (Accounts), payable at Delhi. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/Physically Challenged category are exempted from payment of the fee. (Second class railway or bus fare chargeable by the shortest routes from Railway Station / Bus Stand nearest to their normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey, whichever is nearer to the place of examination, will be reimbursed to SC/ST candidates on production of ticket(s), provided the distance travelled is not less than 30 kms.)

E. DETAILS REGARDING EXAMINATION AND INTERVIEW:

Post-doctoral fellowships will be awarded on the basis of:

- a. Performance in the eligibility examination and interview
- b. The project proposal
- c. An assessment of the candidate's Ph.D. dissertation (to be submitted only if called for the interview).
- F. The Eligibility Examination will be for a maximum of 100 marks to be answered in 3 hours.
- G. Questions can be answered in either English or Hindi.
- H. The Interview carries a maximum of 100 marks.
- I. The candidates will be required to answer one question based on historiography/historical method, one question on the candidates area of specialisation and questions based on a passage from a given source. Adequate choice will be available. The examination will address different specialisations such as: Indian prehistory and archaeology, ancient Indian history, medieval Indian history, modern Indian History, major themes in world history and historiography and related subjects. Candidates are required to familiarise themselves with recent literature on the subject.

J. Candidates who qualify in the eligibility examination will appear for an Interview at the offices of the ICHR in New Delhi. Second class railway or bus fare chargeable by the shortest routes from Railway Station / Bus Stand nearest to their normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey, whichever is nearer to the place of interview, will be reimbursed to eligible candidates on production of tickets.
