1. COOKING WITHOUT FIRE

INSTRUCTIONS:

- A team should consist of one member.
- Cooking by any means is restricted.
- Ingredients will not be provided; should bring by themselves.
- The participants are allowed to carry necessary tool kits.
- Time allotted for the competitions is 45 minutes.

2. POT DESIGNING

INSTRUCTIONS:

- A team should consist of 1 member only.
- Plastic pot of 15cm width and 20cm height should be brought by themselves.
- The participants can carry necessary tool kits.
- Time allotted for the competitions is Two hours.
- No designed pots are allowed

3. BREAD BITING

INSTRUCTIONS:

- This session is opened for students of LP and UP classes
- Separate competition will be held for LP and UP students.

4. DRAWING/ COLOURING/POSTER/CARTOON

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Drawing and painting is meant for LP,UP and HS students
- Colouring competition is exclusively for KG students.
- Cartoon and poster making is restricted to HS and HSS students
- Time allotted for the competitions is Two and half hours.
- The participants can carry necessary tools (crayons, pencil, eraser, scale etc) needed for the competition.
- Chart/ papers needed for the competition will be provided.

5. ETHNIC FOODS

INSTRUCTIONS:

- A team should consist of one member.
- Ingredients will not be provided; should bring by themselves.
- The participants are allowed to carry necessary tool kits.
- Time allotted for the competitions is Two Hours.

6. VEGETABLE & FRUIT CARVING

INSTRUCTIONS:

- A team should consist of 2 members only.
- The team should report to the venue half an hour before the commencement of the competition

- Time allotted for the competitions is Three hours.
- No pre-carved items are entertained
- Switch off the cell phones during the hours.
- Judges decision will be final.

- No pre-designed cloths are to be used

10. VEGETABLE PRINTING

INSTRUCTIONS:

- A team should consist of 1 member only.
- Suitable vegetables should be brought by themselves.
- A piece of cotton cloth having 1 Meter X1 Meter width and length has to be brought
- Time allotted for the competitions is Two hours.
- No pre-designed cloths are to be used
- The participants can carry necessary tool kits.
- No pre-printed cloths are to be used
