I. Assistant Professors

The qualification for the posts of Assistant Professors is as prescribed by UGC. The discipline and number of vacancies are specified below:

Desired Qualification

The eligibility criteria for all posts are as prescribed by University Grants Commission. The applicant should have Post Graduate degree in concerned discipline with minimum of 55% Marks and should have qualified UGC/NET conducted by UGC in the concerned Subject.
