 - ii) BANK DRAFT of Rs.300/- in case of general candidates and Rs.150/- in case of SC/ST/PH candidates must accompany with the application forms.
 - iii) Reservation shall be as per Government of Assam Rules.
 - iv) In service candidates must send their application through proper channel.
 - v) Applications received late and found incomplete will not be considered.
 - vi) A self addressed stamped (worth Rs.6/- envelope size 23 cm x 10 cm should be sent along with the application form.
