ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

- I. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST for reserve post or those who passed their Master's Degree prior to 19.09.1991 and hold a Ph.D. degree) at the Master's degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- II. Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the Candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC.

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1 Candidate who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grant Commission (Minimum standards and procedure for awards of M. Phil/Ph.D. degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- 2 NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Degree Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.
- 3 The candidates applying under PwD category may specifically mention in application their main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.
- 4 The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 29.12.2005. The format is available at the website www.persmin.nic.in
- 5 The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
- 6 The College reserves its right not to fill up any or all the post(s) advertised and to increase or decrease the number of post(s) as per requirement of workload and roster.
- 7 Application form may be obtained from the office of the College from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm on or before the last date of submission either in person or by sending a self addressed and stamped envelope. Application form is also available on the college website www.satyawatievedu.ac.in
- 8 Separate applications have to be submitted for each post.
- 9 Applications on the prescribed form must reach the Principal, Satyawati College (Evening), Ashok Vihar, Phase-III, Delhi-110052 on or before **08.03.2014**, complete in all respects with self attested copies of certificates, mark sheets, testimonials etc. along with a demand draft of Rs. 250/- (for General/OBC) and Rs. 100/- (for SC/ST/PwD) in favour of the 'Principal Satyawati College (Evening)', payable at Delhi.
- 10 Merely fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions does not entitle the candidates to be called for interview. The application received shall be screened in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the University in this regard to restrict the number of candidates.
