1) Professor of ENT -1 post - UR

Essential Qualification: (i) M.S (ENT) or an equivalent degree recognized by the Medical Council of India. (ii) 10 years of experience in postgraduate teaching and clinical work in a recognized institution / hospital.

Desirable: Publications in national and international journals.

Age - below 50 years

Essential Qualification: (i) A doctorate degree in Clinical Psychology (ii) Master's degree in Psychology or an equivalent degree. (iii) M.Phil in Medical and Social Psychology (iv) 10 years of experience in post graduate teaching or research in any University / National Institution.

Desirable: (i) Experience of guiding doctoral students (ii) Publications in national and international journals.

Essential Qualification: (i) Post graduate with Ph.D. in the relevant subject/discipline or its equivalent. (ii) 5 years of experience in postgraduate and graduate teaching or research at any university or national institution.

Desirable: (i) Experience of guiding doctoral students. (ii) Publication in national and international journals.

5) Reader in ENT – 1 post - OBC

Age – below 40 years

Essential Qualification: (i) M.S (ENT) or an equivalent degree recognized by the Medical Council of India. (ii) Five years of experience in postgraduate/Graduate teaching and clinical work in a recognized institution / hospital.

Desirable: Publications in national and international journals

1) Clinical Supervisor - 1 post - SC

Age – Below 30 years

Pay Band - `9300-34800 (PB-2) with Grade Pay of `4200 on an initial basic pay of `13500/- p.m. + Allowances

Essential Qualification: (i) M.Sc in Speech and Hearing (ii) Three year's research / teaching experience.

2) Clinical Psychologist Grade II – 1 post - UR

Age – Below 30 years

Pay Band - `9300-34800 (PB-2) with Grade Pay of `4200 on an initial basic pay of `13500/- p.m. + Allowances.

Essential Qualification: II Class M.A. or M.Sc in Psychology with Clinical Psychology as a special subject.

Desirable: Two years experience in the field.

3) Multi Rehabilitation Worker – 1 post – UR

Age - Below 25 years

Pay Band – `5200-20200 (PB-1) with Grade Pay of `2400/- on an initial basic pay of `9910/- p.m. + Allowances

Essential qualification: (i) 10+2 or equivalent qualification from a recognized Board or University; (ii) One and half year certificate course of Multi Rehabilitation worker from a Government Hospital or recognized institute; (iii) Registered as Rehabilitation Personnel under Rehabilitation Council of India Act 1992.

Desirable: One year experience in the related field.

4) Junior Documentation Assistant - 1 post - PH-HH

Age - Below 26 years

Pay Band – `5200-20200 (PB-1) with Grade Pay of `1900/- on an initial basic pay of `7730/- p.m. + Allowances

Essential qualification: (SSLC with at least one year's experience in operating Xerox, korestat copier, electronic stencil cutter and duplicating machines.

III. Non Technical Post - One

1) Hindi-cum-English Typist – 1 post – UR

Age - Below 25 years

Pay Band – `5200-20200 (PB-1) with Grade Pay of `1900/- on an initial basic pay of `7730/- p.m. + Allowances

Essential qualification: (i) SSLC or equivalent qualification (ii) Minimum speed of 30 words per minute in English Typewriting and 25 words per minute in Hindi Typewriting.

Age Relaxation:

Age should not exceed the limit prescribed for each category of post as on the closing date of receipt of application. Upper age limit is relaxable in respect of SC/ST (5 years) / OBC (3 years) / PWD (10 years) / Ex-servicemen and in-service candidates as per GOI orders.

General Conditions / Information:

- 1. The qualifications prescribed should have been obtained through recognized Universities / Institutions.
- 2. The period of experience in a discipline / area of work, wherever prescribed, shall be counted after the date of acquiring the minimum prescribed educational qualification prescribed for the post.
- 3. Candidates applying for more than one post should submit separate applications for each post **indicating the name of the post** in each application applied for.
- 4. The prescribed Essential Qualifications are a bare minimum and mere possession of it, will not entitle the candidates to be called for interview. Where number of applications received are more in response to an advertisement, it may not be convenient or possible for the institute to interview all the candidates. The Institute may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable limit, on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than that of the minimum prescribed in the advertisement.
