Walk-in-Interview

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for a **“Walk-in-Interview”** for vacant post of Senior Residents / Junior Residents / Tutors / Demonstrator on **REGULAR BASIS** for the following posts. The details about the application process are given below and also available on the institute website www.aiimsrishikesh.edu.in.

I. Essential Qualification:

A. For Senior Residents (Pay Scale: Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay 6600 + NPA)

- A graduate medical degree (M.B,B.S)
- A postgraduate medical degree Viz. MD/MS in the respective discipline from a recognized University/Institute.

B. For Junior Residents(Non Academic, Pay Scale: Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay 5400 + NPA)

- The candidates should have passed MBBS (including completion of Internship) or equivalent degree recognized by MCI.
- Only those candidates who have passed MBBS (including Internship) not earlier than three years before 20. 03.2014.

C. For Tutors/ Demonstrators (Pay Scale: Rs.15600-39100 + Grade Pay 5400 + NPA)

For Medical Candidates:

- The candidates should have passed MBBS (including completion of Internship) /MD or equivalent degree recognised by MCI.
- Only those candidates who have passed MBBS (including Internship) not earlier than three years before 20. 03.2014.

For Non-Medical Candidates:

- *The candidate should possess M.Sc. Degree in the subject concerned from a recognized University/Institute.*
- *Preference will be given to Ph. D. candidates.*

II. Upper Age Limit (as on last date for application submission): senior residents: 33 years, junior residents/tutor/demonstrators: 30 years

- Relaxable for SC/ST candidate up to a maximum period of 05 years, and in the case of OBC candidates up to a maximum period of 03 years.*
- In the case of Orthopaedic Physical Handicapped (OPH) candidates, relaxable upto maximum period of 05 years for General Category, 08 years for OBC category and 10 years for SC/ST category candidates.*
- For those applying for these posts after completing DM/M.Ch courses, the upper age limit will be 35 years. The age limit is further relaxable for SC/ST candidates, OBC candidates & OPH candidates as mentioned above.*

III. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/OPH shall be applicable as per Govt. of India rules.

V. Application process

- The application, interview and selection process will continue on monthly basis till the required posts for the institute are filled.
- The candidates should submit their application in prescribed format (available on website) along with attested copies of documents (listed below) and application fee demand draft in a single envelop to the Recruitment Cell, Ground floor, Medical College Building, AIIMS Rishikesh, Virbhadra Road, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand, 249201, **by 7th of every month**.
- The post and specialty in which the candidate has applied should be clearly mentioned with bold letters on the top of the application envelop.
- The application fee should be in form of bank draft of Rs. 500/- (Rs.100/- in case of SC/ST candidates) (Non refundable) in favor of “**AIIMS RISHIKESH**” payable at Rishikesh. Name of applicant along with telephone number should be written on the back side of demand draft. No application fee is applicable for person with disabilities.
- The walk-in-interview will be held on **15th of each month** in Academic Section, AIIMS. In case of any weekly or gazetted holiday falling on these dates, the interview will be conducted on next working day. The candidates will required to be present ‘in person’ along with original certificates and 2 passport sized photographs at **9:30 AM in Dean Office**.

3. Institute will not be responsible for any postal delays in the delivery of applications.
4. The appointment to the said post will be subject to medical fitness from the competent medical board.
5. Candidates employed in Govt. & Semi Govt. Organizations, Public Undertakings, University and Educational Institutions must submit ‘no objection certificate’ along with the application form.
6. Separate application has to be filled for each post applied.
