Essential Qualification for the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer:

- 1. Good academic record with at least 55% (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST or those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19.09.1991 and hold a Ph.D degree) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or and equivalent degree from a foreign University.
- 2. Candidates must have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC (SLET/SET).

General Note:-

- 1. Candidates who have been awarded Ph. D degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/ Ph. D degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- 2. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Master's Degree Programme in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.

- 3. Any relaxation in the prescribed qualification can only be made by the UGC in a particular subject in which NET is not being conducted or enough number of candidates are not available with NET qualification.
- 4. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
- 5. Age relaxation as per Govt. of India and University of Delhi Guidelines.
- 6. The candidates may specifically mention in their application the category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC/PwD. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Persons with disabilities categories should submit attested copy of certificate issued by competent authority in the prescribed format as stipulated by government of India. In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, certificate should specifically contain a clause that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer section excluded from the benefits of reservation for Other Backward Classes in Civil Post & service under Government of India. Copy of SC/ST/OBC certificate should be attached mentioning Central list number in application.
- 7. The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
- 8. The college reserves the right to change the number and/or the nature of posts and/or not to fill any or all the posts advertised without assigning any reason thereof.
- 9. No T.A or D.A will be paid for appearing in the written test and interview.
- 10. The College shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at the time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are false or the candidate has suppressed relevant information, then his/her services shall be terminated without prejudice to any other action initiated by the College.
- 11. The College shall not be responsible for any delay/loss due to postal or technical reasons.
- 12. Merely fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions does not entitle the conditions to be called for interview. The applications received shall be screened in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the University in this regard to restrict the no. of candidates.

- 15. The PwD candidates with less than 40% of relevant disability shall not be considered for the post reserved for PwD. The disability certificate should be issued by the competent Authority duly authorized by the Central or the State Government. The candidates are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No.36035/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 29.12.2005. The format is available at the website www.persmin.nic.in.
