Note :

1. All degree/diploma should be from a recognized institution.
2. M.AEd./M.Sc.Ed./BSc.Ed.from NIE with desired subjects are also eligible.
3. English as a subject in class XII is mandatory for all posts.
4. The candidate should be competent enough to teach through English Medium.
5. Upper age limit may be relaxed in case of meritorious candidates with teaching experience at the discretion of the interview board.
6. The candidates securing a minimum 50% marks for General Category and 45% marks for Reserved Category in written test only will be eligible for interview.
7. For PGTs Normally preference will be given to candidates with teaching qualifications (B.Ed.). However, if the performance of a candidate without a B.Ed. is found to be exceptionally good with good academic record she/he may be considered for appointment.

Interested candidates may report for registration **on the scheduled dates one hour before** the schedule of the written test. They should bring attested copies of the certificate/testimonials along with originals and a passport photograph for verification.
