

THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

MISSION

The Department of Education is committed to encourage inter-disciplinary higher education and research to spread knowledge to every strata of the society. It aims at creating an innovative, value-based, and research oriented world-class learning environment and establishing itself as a Centre of excellence.

Central Institute of Education (CIE), also known as the Faculty and the Department of Education of the University of Delhi, was established in 1947. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, and the first Education Minister of independent India, Maulana AbulKalam Azad took considerable interest in CIE's establishment and its activities and progress in early years. Maulana Azad visualised the function of CIE as not merely to "turn out teachers who will be 'model teachers', but to evolve into 'a research centre for solving new educational problems of the country'; one that would grow into 'a beacon light for training institutions of the country.'" Over past decades, CIE has grown into a pace-setting institution in Teacher Education and Educational Research. Starting as a teachers' college, offering a Bachelor of teaching degree (evolving to the first B.Ed. degree in 1951), it became a full-fledged Department of Education of the University of Delhi in 1979. Recognised as an Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE) and having launched the Maulana Azad Centre for Elementary and Social Education (MACESE), CIE has shaped its unique philosophy which finds reflection in its academic programmes.

THE MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.) PROGRAMME

The Master of Education Programme of the Department of Education (Central Institute of Education) was launched in the early years after the independence of our country. It was conceived as a professional programme for advanced study of the discipline of Education. The programme offers a comprehensive overview of 'Education' embedded in the foundational disciplines of Philosophy, Sociology and Psychology, and a detailed study of chosen specialized areas of interest. Since M.Ed. is also a degree leading to research in Education, the course has a strong research component which includes Dissertation Writing. The objectives of the M.Ed. programme include academic study, sensitisation toward critical issues in Education and becoming proactive practitioners in various fields like text book writing, curriculum reform, policy studies, administration, special education, guidance and counselling etc. The M.Ed. Scholars are also being trained for tutorship and school supervision. To develop their research acumen and potential, regular in-house Research Seminars are conducted.

Medium of instruction is English. However, either English or Hindi can be used to write the examination as well as the research dissertation as long as the same medium is followed throughout the exam and/or dissertation.

M.Ed. is offered in two modes:

- -Full time M.Ed. of the duration of 1 academic year for non-working candidates;
- -Part-time M.Ed. of the duration of 2 academic years for working candidates.






IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS

- Rounding of fractions will not be allowed while computing the percentage of marks for eligibility.
- The written test may be attempted in Hindi or English.
- No travelling allowance or reimbursement will be made to any candidate at any stage.
- Any Candidate who is employed shall not be admitted to the M.Ed. (Full-time) programme unless s/he produces a valid sanction of leave from the employer.
- Every candidate applying to the M.Ed. (Part-time) programme must produce a permission/N.O.C. from his/her employer to join and pursue the programme.
- M.Ed. (full-time)students are not permitted to take up any employment (Part-time or Full-time)
- No M.Ed. student is allowed to study for any other examination, while pursuing this programme.

FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS

- There are two small dormitory-type hostels in Central Institute of Education (CIE), separately for men and women, but only for Full Time M.Ed. students. The application for seat allotment should be submitted immediately after admission.
- Scholarships of Rs. 200/- p.m. may be granted to all M.Ed. (Full-Time) students, as per University norms.
