## **General instructions for the candidates:**

- 1. The crucial date for determining the age limit of candidates will be the closing date for receipt of applications. The last date for receipt of the application is 30 days from the date of publication of the advertisement in the Employment News.
- 2. Age relaxation: Upper age relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC and 10 years for PH candidates. (The maximum age limit for ICAR employees will be relaxable up to 45 years for the post of Lower Division Clerk and 43 years for the post of Stenographer Grade III.) There will be no age limit for the employees of the Council for the above Technical posts.
- 3. The Research Associates/Sr. Research Fellows who have been engaged on contractual basis by different Projects in ICAR Institutes without break for less than six months as on date be considered with their qualifications by granting them appropriate relaxation in the upper
