The Scholastic Aptitude Test consists of 100 items. Of these 40 are from Science, 20 from Mathematics and 40 from Social Sciences. Each item carries one mark. You are to answer all the items on a separate answer sheet as per instructions given on the booklet as well as on the answer sheet and as explained in the instructions enclosed.

Note : There will be negative marking for all the above tests. For each wrong answer 1/3 marks will be deducted. No marks will be deducted for unattempted questions.

Instructions to the Candidate

1. Keep your admission card very carefully and bring it to the Examination Hall on the day of the examination, **affixing your passport size photograph attested by the Principal/Headmaster of the Institution** where you are/were studying in Class X or by any Gazetted officer.
2. Please bring your own pen, ink, etc., on the date of examination.
3. Write your Roll No. (as given in the admission card) on the cover page of the test booklet and on the answer sheets in international numerals only in the space provided for the purpose and write your name on the answer sheet.
4. You have to indicate the answers on separate answer sheets for the tests to be provided to you at the time of examination as per instructions given on them and explained in the enclosed specimen.
5. Sign on the admission card, in the space provided, in the examination hall in the presence of the invigilator.
6. **Hand over the answer sheets to the Invigilator before you leave the examination hall.**
7. The name of the examination centre and the national level Roll No. should be indicated while making any reference to the NCERT. However, no correspondence shall be entertained in connection with the result, etc.
8. Postal address, if changed, should be intimated immediately to Section Officer, Examination Section, (NTS-I) ESD, NCERT, Sri Aurobindo Marg, New Delhi 110016.
9. Candidates have to bear the expenses for appearing in this examination.
10. There will be negative marking. For each wrong answer 1/3 marks will be deducted. No marks will be deducted for unattempted questions.
11. It may be noted that the qualifying marks in each i.e. MAT, LANGUAGE and SAT tests is 40% for General category candidates and 32% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/Physically challenged categories.
12. Write down the booklet number on the answer sheet (in the box provided for it) as given on the question booklet.
13. Use of calculators, slide rules, log tables or cell phones is not allowed,
14. Only in exceptional cases a candidate may ask for **change of centre within 15 days** from the date of issue of the admission letter. No such request **will be entertained within 15 days** from the date of examination. However, it may be noted that in such cases only the test booklet in regional language, which has questions in English language also, shall be provided to the candidate at the changed centre. **Please do not ask for change of centre, if only 15 days for the examination are left.**
