## **INSTRUCTIONS (2014-15)**

- 1. Write name of the candidate as mentioned in the qualifying examination certificate. (Point No. 1 of Application Form)
- 2. Write the appropriate category against which you are seeking admission and "PH" if you are physically challenged. Certificate from the competent authority has to be enclosed failing which the claim will be rejected. (Point No. 4)
- 3. Write the appropriate State/UT against which you are seeking admission. [MP=Madhya Pradesh, CG=Chhattisgarh, MH= Maharashtra, GJ= Gujarat, Goa= Goa, D&D= Daman and Diu, D&NH= Dadra and Nagar Haveli]. As a proof of eligibility of State/UT for admission the candidate has to produce any one of the Following: (Point No. 5)
  - a) Evidence of having passed the qualifying examination from the State/UT as given in the advertisement.
  - b) In case the legal guardian/parent/spouse is an employee of State/Central Govt./ Govt. of India Undertaking, the Latest certificate of place of posting in the State/UT.
  - c) A domicile certificate from the competent authority.

To decide your State/UT, first see if (a) is applicable, If (a) is not applicable, then according to (b). If both (a) & (b) are not applicable, then according to (c).

- 4. The date of birth should be as per High School Certificate. e.g. 06/12/1997. (Point No. 6)
- 5. Parents annual income certificate of 2013-14 should be attached. (Point No. 7)
- 6. Separate applications are required for different courses. The candidate should have passed the subjects opted in the course at the qualifying examination. (Relaxable in B.A.B.Ed.). (Point No. 12)
  - ❖ Write "Science & Mathematics" if opting for Two Year B.Ed. (Secondary) Science & Maths Group.
  - ❖ Write "Language & Social Science" if opting for Two Year B.Ed. (Secondary) Language & Social Science Group.
  - ❖ If opting for B.A.B.Ed. write any one language [Hindi, English, Urdu, Marathi and Gujarati ] at A and Social Science [History or Geography and Economics or Political Science] at B and C respectively.]
- 7. Photocopies of both sides of the mark-sheets/certificates should be provided to indicate the method of calculating the percentage given by the University.
- 8. Applicants in regular employment will have to route their application through proper channel with an undertaking that they would be deputed on full time basis. However, an advance copy of the application form with documents must reach by the due date.
- 9. Deputed candidates from various organizations/educational institutions are required to submit relieving/No Objection Certificate from their respective departments before joining the course.
- 10. It is mandatory to affix recent passport size photograph on the application form.
- 11. The candidate should support the information given in the application with relevant documents without which the application will be rejected. Mark sheets should be self attested.

- 12. Candidates will be called for interview strictly according to the merit and quota available for each State.
- 13. The Institute reserves the right to run a particular course or to restrict the subjects combinations/options offered for courses.
- 14. The candidate should have passed all Examinations from recognized Board/University.
- 15. The candidates will have to fulfill the conditions of domicile as laid down in the application form.
