# EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS (For all posts)

Minimum 03 years hands on experience in maintaining/servicing of Seaking helicopters in Airframe/Electrical trades.

Should be able to plan & execute the work independently for defect rectification / servicing of Helicopters.

Knowledge in interpreting SeaKing Helicopter documentation, drawings, process sheets, maintenance of tools & equipments, fault diagnosis and rectification capabilities.

Should have been qualified to maintain/supervise / sign activities in their respective trade on SeaKing Helicopters

#### SKILLS & ABILITIES (For post at sl.nos.3 & 4)

Should be able to work independently for servicing of Helicopters.

Knowledge in interpreting SeaKing Helicopter documentation, drawings, process sheets, maintenance of tools & equipments, fault diagnosis and rectification capabilities. Should have been qualified to maintain/sign activities in their respective trade on SeaKing Helicopters

### AGE LIMIT / RELAXATION / CONCESSION

Maximum age limit for all posts is 28 years as on 14/12/2013. Reservation / concessions for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC / PWD and XSM categories would be made as per Government Directives.

- Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in respect of SC/ST candidates and 3 years in respect of OBC candidates (non-creamy layer).
- PWD candidates (only orthopaedically disabled) are eligible to apply. Upper age limit is relaxable by 10 years in respect of PWD candidates with 40% & above disability (OH).
- Candidates belonging to the OBC Category are required to produce recently obtained Community Certificate in proof of their Community (not older than 6 months as on 14/12/2013, stating that they do not come under the creamy layer, from a Competent

Authority, in the prescribed format and Candidates belonging to the SC/ST/PWD Category are also required to produce their Community / Disability Certificate in proof of their Community / Disability in the prescribed format (Format for posts under Govt. of India).

- For candidates who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period of 01-01-1980 to 31-12-1989, upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years.
- \* Relaxation in age limit in respect of Ex-Servicemen will be extended as per rules.

#### PLACE OF POSTING

The selected candidates will be posted to HAL Base at Kochi, Kerala. However, they are liable to the transferred to any place in India where HAL has Divisions/ Offices. No request for change of posting will be entertained after joining.

### TENURE OF ENGAGEMENT & ABSORPTION

The selected candidates will be engaged on contract basis initially for a period of one year with effect from the date of joining duty. The contract period may be extended by one more year depending upon the availability of work & organizational requirements at the discretion of the Management, subject to assessment with regard to conduct and performance during the one year period. On successful completion of the two year period, they will be considered for absorption subject to suitability and availability of vacancy.

# **EMOLUMENTS**

Ex-Servicemen technicians engaged on contract basis will be paid consolidated emoluments (Basic+DA+HRA) based on their post qualification experience. The consolidated emoluments per month can vary between Rs.17,060/- to Rs.19,880/- for candidates with NAC/NCTVT qualification and between Rs.18,030/- to Rs.21,110/- for candidates with qualification of Diploma in Engineering. They are also eligible for Washing Allowance, Conveyance Allowance / Reimbursement, Reimbursement of School Fee in respect of dependent children, as per prevailing rules. After absorption they are eligible for regular pay as given to respective scales. Besides that, they are entitled for DA, HRA/Company accommodation, Canteen Allowance, Conveyance allowance, Interest Subsidy on Loans etc. as per prevailing rules,

# **HEALTH**

Applicants should be of sound health and should meet the medical standards prescribed by the Company. Appointment of selected candidates will be subject to receipt of satisfactory medical report from the Company's Doctor as per the Medical Standards of the Company.

# APPLICATION FEE

The application fee of Rs. 200/- which is non-refundable, is to be sent in the form of Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank (preferably State Bank of India) in favour of 'HAL - Helicopter MRO Division', payable at Bangalore. Candidates belonging to SC / ST/PWD category are exempted from payment of Application Fee. The date of issue of the DD should be between 20/11/2013 and 14/12/2013. The candidate is required to write his name and post applied for on the reverse side of the Demand Draft.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

Eligible candidates short-listed based on the initial screening will be called for Written Test. Candidates qualified in the written test will be subjected for a Personal Interview. The date, Time and Venue of the Written Test / Interview will be intimated to the short-listed candidates by **E-mail / HAL Website only**. Candidates are required to bring the documents / testimonials (Original and self attested Photocopies) in proof of Age, Qualification, Experience, Training, Caste etc at the time of Interview.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Only Indian Nationals and ex-Indian Navy personnel need to apply.
- Applicants serving in Government/Public Sector, Semi-Government Organizations should forward applications through their Employer and also produce "No Objection Certificate" at the time of Written Test / Interview.
- CGPA, FCPI etc wherever applicable should compulsorily be converted into percentage of marks as per the University / Institution norms.
- Candidate must indicate the aggregate marks (of all semesters / years put together) Diploma / Degree etc in the Bio-data form (Annexure-1). Aggregate marks are to be calculated as shown below:
