4.0 POSTS AND EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

4.1 **FOR NON-TECHNICAL POPULAR CATEGORIES (POSTS WITH GP ₹ 1,900/-):**
Passed Matriculation or its equivalent with not less than 50% marks in aggregate.
Minimum percentage of 50% marks in aggregate is not applicable to SC/ST candidates and to those candidates (irrespective of community), who possess qualifications higher than matriculation such as HSC / Intermediate / Graduation / Post Graduation.

6.0 EXAMINATION FEES :

6.1 The examination fee of ₹ 40/- (Rupees Forty only) for post with grade pay of ₹ 1,900/- and ₹ 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) for post with grade pay of ₹ 1,800/- is payable either in the form of Demand Drafts (DD) / Indian Postal Orders (IPO), drawn in favour of 'Assistant Personnel Officer / Recruitment', payable at Chennai.

6.2 DDs and IPOs issued before the date of issue of this Employment Notice or after the closing date will not be accepted and the Application Form will be rejected.

6.3 Applications received with Cash / Cheque / Central Recruitment Fee Stamps and Money Orders will not be accepted and will be REJECTED.

6.4 Candidates must write their name, full address at the space provided in the postal order / at the back of Demand Draft.

6.5 The examination fee is not refundable / transferable / adjustable under any circumstances.

6.6 FEE EXEMPTIONS :

SC/ST candidates, Ex-Servicemen, Persons with Disabilities, Women candidates, Minority* candidates and candidates belonging to Economically Backward Classes** are exempted from payment of examination fees.

Note:

* Minorities will mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists and Zoroastrians (Parsis).
** Economically backward classes will mean the candidates whose family income is less than ₹ 50,000/- per annum.

6.7 Authorities competent to issue income certificates for the purpose of identifying economically backward classes.

- (i) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tahsildar.
- (ii) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.
- (iii) Below Poverty Line (BPL) Card or any other certificate issued by Central Government under a recognised poverty alleviation programme of Izzat MST issued by Railways.
- (iv) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the country.
- (v) Sitting Member of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the District in which these MPs normally reside.

Note: Candidates claiming 'Fee Exemptions' shall enclose a copy of the certificate in the prescribed format ('Proforma' is available in the website).

7.0 COMMUNITY CERTIFICATE

7.1 No post is exclusively reserved for OBC and SC / ST candidates.

7.2 The candidates claiming to belong to OBC and SC/ST communities are required to produce Community Certificates from the Competent Authority in the prescribed format ('Proforma' is available in the website) and enclose a copy of the same with the application.

7.3 The Community Certificates produced by the OBC candidates should specifically indicate that the candidate does not belong to persons / sections (creamy layer).

8.0 MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prescribed for the posts to be identified by the Southern Railway administration.

9.0 CHOICE OF LANGUAGE FOR QUESTION PAPER

The candidates must choose any one of the following languages only and indicate the same in the Application Form:

Hindi or Urdu or English or Tamil or Malayalam or Kannada or Telugu.

10.0 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

10.1 The candidates applying in response to this notification shall ensure that he / she fulfills all eligibility conditions at the time of submission of Application.

10.2 **Photo:** One Passport Size photograph (not older than one month) (in Scout / Guide uniform in case applying against Scouts & Guides quota) should be pasted on the application form, at the space specified.

10.3 **Enclosures: Self-attested Photostat copy of the certificates** in support of Age, Community, Educational Qualifications and Cultural / Scouting Qualifications, etc. Further, Indian Postal Order / Demand Draft in original or necessary proof for claiming fee exemption, etc. should be enclosed along with the application form.

10.4 **Certificates in languages other than English or Hindi** should be accompanied by an attested translation in English / Hindi.

10.5 **Serving employee and Staff of Quasi administrative offices of Railway Organisations:** "No Objection Certificate" or "Bonafide Certificate" giving the length of regular service etc. from the employer should be attached.

10.6 **Divorced / Judicially separated Women:** Copy of Decree from the competent court of law for having divorced / judicially separated along with an Affidavit that she has not remarried since should be enclosed.

10.7 **Widow:** Death Certificate of her husband together with an Affidavit that she has not remarried since should be enclosed.

10.8 **Ex-Servicemen:** Discharge Certificate should be enclosed.

10.9 **Persons with Disability:** Disability Certificate issued by Medical Board of the appropriate Government in the prescribed format ('Proforma' is available in the website) should be enclosed.

10.10 Candidates belonging to **Minority Community and Economically Backward Classes** shall enclose documentary proof in support of their claim.

10.11 **Finger Prints:** Left Thumb Impression should be affixed in such a manner that the ridges are clearly visible.

10.12 **Original Certificates / Documents :** It is the responsibility of the candidates to produce Original Certificates / Documents at the time of Document Verification, without fail. Failure to produce the Original Certificates/Documents will result in rejection of the candidature.

- 10.13** The candidates' admission at all stages of the recruitment will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.
- 10.14** In Written Examination, there will be negative marking for wrong answers.
- 10.15** All the candidates are advised to browse www.rrcchennai.org.in to know their Application eligible status.
- 10.16** The candidate shall attend the Written Examination / Document Verification / Interview / Personality Test / Medical Examination at the date, time and venue specified by Railway administration.

- 10.18** **Travel Expenses:** SC/ST candidates alone will be issued with **II-Class Free Pass** for their journey from their nearest Railway Station to the venue of Written Examination / Document Verification / Medical Examination. Others will have to make their own arrangements. No reimbursement of travel expenses will be made on any account.
- 10.19** **Accommodation:** All the candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their accommodation while coming for Written Examination, Document Verification and Medical Examination. They must also come prepared to stay for few days, if required. RRC will not make any arrangement for providing accommodation.
- 10.20** Mere issue of call letter to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared.
- 10.21** Railway administration will not be responsible for postal delay or wrong delivery, if any, of any correspondence, at any stage of the recruitment process.
- 10.22** Railway administration reserves the right to alter the stages of examination or conduct re-examination or cancel part or whole of any recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 10.23** Decision of Railway administration in all matters relating to recruitment will be final and binding on the candidates. It will not be possible to entertain any enquiry or correspondence while the recruitment process is going on.
